Simplifying FAFSA for Foster Youth with JBAY



If you've spent time in foster care, you're in a prime position to unlock significant financial aid for college or vocational schools through the FAFSA, including Pell and Chafee ETV grants - essentially free money that doesn't need to be repaid. By completing the FAFSA, you can access Pell Grants, offering \$4K-\$6K, and if you were in foster care for any period between ages 16 and 18, you're also eligible for an additional \$5K yearly for education or vocational training.

To aid in this endeavor, The John Burton Advocates for Youth (JBAY) team has compiled essential insights into the FAFSA process tailored specifically for foster youth. Here's a quick glance at what we've unpacked for you:
